The Museum of Solutions (MuSo) is seeking a Head of Exhibit Creation to join its growing team.

MuSo is a new, world-class children's museum being developed by the JSW Foundation and partners in Mumbai, India. MuSo's vision is to inspire, enable, and empower children to make meaningful change in the world together, today.

MuSo's learning and engagement model is hands-on, fun, and playful — but also focused on the real world. The museum's programs and exhibits are designed to cultivate the knowledge, skills, and actions kids need to tackle the challenges they see around them and make progress on the UN Sustainable Development Goals. MuSo will be the first interactive and immersive learning environment of its kind for children in India.

The Head of Exhibit Creation will be responsible for exhibition design and fabrication for MuSo's purpose-built 6,000 square meter museum building, scheduled for partial opening in 2021.

The incumbent will report to the Founding Director and will build a small team to develop an exhibition design and production studio at the museum.

This position requires a combination of flexible and creative out-of-the-box thinking with a practical, deadline and budget-focused mindset; great design and artistic communication skills; fluency in CADD and the ability to produce shop drawings and work with architectural plans, as well as the ability to work informally with local artisans and fabricators; a firm grasp of exhibition lifecycles; and an outgoing, collaborative, and team-loving personality with a flair for helping people (visitors, colleagues, kids) succeed.

Duties include leading, in a collaborative environment,

- Concept development and experience design for exhibitions and public spaces.
- Prototyping, testing, and co-creation with audiences, partners, and makers/builders.
- Detailed design and budgeting, including the production of floor plans and renderings for major experiences throughout the museum.
- Project management; the supervision of fabrication and installation; and the delivery of finished exhibition spaces.

Applicants should have 5-10 years' experience designing and creating exhibitions for museums or museum-like spaces. Experience with young audiences and familiarity with India are a plus.

Compensation: Approximately \$50,000 - \$70,000 USD with benefits, housing, and relocation expenses available.

Term and location: This is intended to be a permanent position based in Mumbai. The initial contract will be for 18 months and during this time work can be performed remotely.

Applicants should be prepared to begin work in January, 2021.
